

HMS Year 5 English Tasks - 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe' by C. S. Lewis

Week Nine

This is your final week of reading 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe', so there is only the final chapter left to read and complete comprehension activities about. There are also additional writing and creative tasks for you to choose from to complete – you don't have to do all of these, but you should aim to do at least one or two of these tasks. The text is available for you to read in chapters as PDF's on the school website, however if you have your own copy or another way of reading it, please feel free. Once you have finished reading the book, there are then some additional tasks about the author for you to complete, and finally a book review.

- **Read Chapter 17: The Hunting of the White Stag**
- Complete the Chapter 17 vocabulary and comprehension activities (answers are available so you can mark them afterwards) and challenge yourself with some of the extension activities.
- **Read the information about C.S. Lewis**
- Complete the comprehension and time line activities, based on what you have read about the author.

Finally, I'd like you to write a detailed review about the novel – you can use the template provided or you can create your own. I really hope you have enjoyed reading 'The Lion, the Witch and The Wardrobe' as much as I do.

As well as the work on 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe', you should also continue reading your own books, quizzing on **Accelerated Reader** if possible.

This week is the second week of Term 3B – you will need to learn the spellings and copy them out using your neatest handwriting – at the end of the week ask someone to test you on them 😊.
